Abstract Submission

Abstracts should be submitted by e-mail (Word or PDF format) to Dr. Boel Fransson (bfransso@vetmed.wsu.edu) by December 21st, 2011. Make sure you receive a reply to confirm your abstract has been received and can be opened.

Abstract Format: Abstracts should be typed in Times New Roman, single spaced, with the abstract text no more than one page in length and with 1 inch margins. Figures can be added in an appendix page (2 figures maximum; both must be on the same page). If the abstract exceeds 250 words, a truncated or "short version" limited to 250 words is required for publication in proceedings in order to not endanger future publication rights.

Title: Bold Times New Roman, size 12 font

Authors: Include abbreviation (such as DACVS) for diplomate status. Underline name of presenting author.

Affiliations/Addresses: Times New Roman 12 font, single space

Text of Abstract: Times New Roman 12, single space, 1 in margin
